TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF USE BY VEHICLES (ROAD CLOSURE)

St Rayn Hill in the Parish of West Crewkerne

21 DAY NOTICE

NOTICE is hereby given that Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under **section 14(2)** of the Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, will introduce a temporary prohibition of use by vehicles (road closure) on the lengths of road listed in Schedule 1 to this Notice.

This Notice is required for **Somerset Highways to carry out removal of Ash dieback trees for safety reasons, to prevent harm to persons or property from diseased trees falling on the highway** on or near the roads listed in Schedule 1. The restrictions may not be effected for the whole of the period but it is anticipated that the roads will be restricted as and when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessary to execute the works for a period not exceeding **twenty-one days**;

The works are anticipated to be operative from **7th August 2020 to 24th August 2020 for 18 days** between the hours of **08:30HRS - 16:30HRS**.
